

**CITY OF DALTON GARDENS
KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO
ORDINANCE NO 279**

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,210,075.39 TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, AUTHORIZING A LEVY OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE, PROVIDING FOR A LEVY OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY TO YIELD \$175,097.00 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho as follows:

Section 1: That the sum of \$1,210,075.39 is, and the same is appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022.

Section 2: The objects and purposes for which such appropriation is made, and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows:

GENERAL FUND

Section 3: That a general tax levy on all taxable property with the City of Dalton Gardens be levied in an amount of \$175,097.00 for the general purposes for said City, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022.


Section 4: The ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. Should any portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect and shall be read to carry out the purposes of the ordinance before the declaration of partial invalidity.

Section 5: All provisions of the current Hayden Municipal Code or ordinances of the City of Hayden which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval, and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Dalton Gardens, and the official newspaper of said City.

PASSED under suspension of rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted at a regular meeting of Mayor and City Council held on the 11th day of August, 2022.
