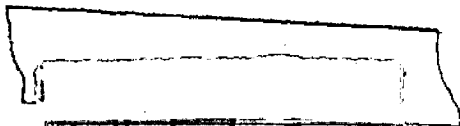

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF HOLDING REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO, BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:
