

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, AND REQUIRING ALL WRITINGS THAT ARE REQUIRED BY VIRTUE OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SAID VILLAGE TO BE PUBLISHED IN THE Coeur d'Alene Press.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper printed and published in the City of Coeur d'Alene and a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho, is hereby appointed, designated and constituted the official newspaper of the Village of Dalton Gardens, and all ordinances, and/or writings as are required under and by virtue of the municipal government of said village to be published in a newspaper, shall be published in said Coeur d'Alene Press.

SECTION II: All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage and approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, the official newspaper of the Village of Dalton Gardens:
