

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1st DAY OF JANUARY, 1964, APPROPRIATING \$16,899.43 TO PAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR THE SAID YEAR, LEVYING SUFFICIENT TAX UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR THE GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Dalton Gardens:

SECTION I: That the sum of \$16,899.43 be appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities for the Village of Dalton Gardens, for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of January, 1964.

SECTION II: That the objects and purposes for which said appropriation is made and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows, to-wit:

SECTION III: That a general tax upon all taxable property within the limits of said Village sufficient to raise the sum of \$2,256.08 be levied for said fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of January, 1964.

SECTION IV: That anticipated other revenues of the said Village for said fiscal year beginning January 1st, 1964, are \$6,389.45, the unexpended general fund balance is \$8,253.92.

SECTION V: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Kootenai County, Idaho.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the Village of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held on March 10th, 1964.
