

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CERTAIN NAMES AND/OR NAMING STREETS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, ADOPTING A MAP UPON WHICH STREETS ARE DESIGNATED AS THE "OFFICIAL MAP OF STREETS" WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Dalton Gardens:

SECTION I: That the names of all streets within the Village of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, shall be as shown on the map which is entitled "Official Map of Streets", a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully set out herein, and such map, when it has been signed by the Chairman and Clerk and filed with the Clerk of the Village shall be a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION II: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, being the official newspaper of said Village.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the Village of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dalton Gardens held on March 7th, 1965.
