ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR, COUNCILMEN, AND FIXING THE COMPENSATION THEREFOR:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That there shall be elected at the next regular city election of the Village of Dalton Gardens, to be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November, 1967, a Mayor and one (1) Councilman to serve for a term of four (4) years.

SECTION II: At the next succeeding general city election, there shall be elected two (2) Councilmen, each to serve a term of four (4) years, and one (1) Councilman to serve a term of two (2) years.

SECTION III: That the compensation to be paid to the Mayor shall be the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month, and to the Councilmen, the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars per month commencing January 1, 1968.

SECTION IV: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said Village, published and printed in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, being the official newspaper of said Village.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and enacted an ordinance of the Village of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held on August 15, 1967, at 8:00 P.M.
