ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO, PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF, GIVING AWAY OF OR SALE AND/OR DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS OF ANY KIND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF SAID CITY: PROVIDING THE PENALTY THEREFOR:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS:

SECTION I: That it shall be unlawful to possess, sell, give away or discharge any fireworks as defined in Sections 39-2607, 39-2608, 39-2609 and 39-2610 of the Idaho Code within the municipal limits of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho.

SECTION II: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by fine in any sum not exceeding Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars or imprisonment in the County Jail of Kootenai County, Idaho, for a period not to exceed Thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION III: All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Kootenai County, Idaho.
