ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE NUMBERING OF RESIDENCES WITHIN THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, ESTABLISHING A PLAN FOR NUMBERING AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR NUMBERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS; KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That all residences within the City of Dalton Gardens or hereinafter constructed within the City of Dalton Gardens shall be numbered in accordance with the map and plan showing the numbering system of such residences now on file in the office of the Clerk of said City and designated the Official Numbering Plan of the City of Dalton Gardens.

SECTION II: The numbers shall be in figures not less than three inches high and one-half inch wide on or of metal or glass placed in a conspicuous position on each residence and shall be plainly legible from the street or avenue upon which such residence has its principal entrance. Such numbers shall be placed and exhibited on each and every residence, and each and every residence hereafter erected within the said City shall have exhibited on the street side thereof the number of said residence in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance within thirty days after the completion thereof.

SECTION III: This Ordinance supersedes and repeals any previous ordinance which may conflict with the provisions herein.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Dalton Gardens, and the official newspaper of said City.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Dalton Gardens, and the official newspaper of said City.
