ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, 1970, APPROPRIATING \$26,975.22 TO PAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR THE SAID YEAR, LEVYING SUFFICIENT TAX UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR THE GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dalton Gardens:

SECTION I: That the sum of \$26,975.22 be appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities for the City of Dalton Gardens for the fiscal year commencing on the First day of January, 1970.

SECTION II: That the objects and purposes for which said appropriation is made and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows, to-wit:

SECTION III: That a general tax upon all taxable
or
property within the limits of said City sufficient to raise
the sum of \$5,600.00 be levied for said fiscal year commencing
on the firstday of January, 1970.

SECTION IV: That anticipated other revenues of said
City for said fiscal year beginning January 1, 1970, are
\$14,044.91; the unexpended general fund balance is \$7,330.31.

SECTION V: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances
in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: That this ordinance shall take effect and
be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication
in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of
general circulation published in Kootenai County, Idaho.
