

CITY OF DALTON GARDENS

ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE "INTERIM EXPENDITURE ORDINANCE" TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, DURING THE PERIOD JANUARY 1 TO MARCH 31, 1971.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby appropriated the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$ 7500⁰⁰) for payment of salaries and expenses of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho, during the period January 1, 1971, to March 31, 1971, while the Mayor and City Council prepare the proposed budget, hold a public hearing, and adopt the annual appropriation bill.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Dalton Gardens and the official newspaper thereof.

Passed under suspension of rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the City Council held on January 7, 1971, at 8:00 P.M.
