ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, ADOPTING THE IDAHO MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS, REVISED THROUGH ACTS OF THE 1969 LEGISLATIVE SESSION, PUBLISHED BY AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT, FOR REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE MUNICIPALITY:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That a certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, marked and designated as IDAHO MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS, Revised through the Acts of the 1969 Legislative Session, Published by Authority of the Department of Law Enforcement, Boise, Idaho, be and hereby is adopted as the Motor Vehicle Code of the City of Dalton Gardens, for the regulation of motor vehicles within the municipality.

SECTION 2: Any violation of any of the provisions of said Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$300.00 or imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper

of general circulation in said City, and printed and published at Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho, being the official newspaper of said City of Dalton Gardens.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was duly taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 4th day of February, 1971.
