ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE "INTERIM EXPENDITURE ORDINANCE" TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, DURING THE PERIOD JANUARY 1 TO MARCH 31, 1973:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby appropriated the sum of Twelve Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$12,000.00) for payment of salaries and expenses of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho, during the period January 1, 1973 to March 31, 1973, while the Mayor and City Council prepare the proposed budget, hold a public hearing, and adopt the annual appropriation bill.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Dalton Gardens and the official newspaper thereof.

Passed under suspension of rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the City Council held on January 11, 1973, at 8:00 P.M.

SECTION III: That a general tax upon all taxable property within the limits of said City sufficient to raise the sum of \$8,500.00 be levied for said fiscal year commencing on the first day of January, 1972.

SECTION IV: That anticipated other revenues of said City for said fiscal year beginning January 1, 1972, are \$31,196.27; the unexpended general fund balance is \$14,384.58.

SECTION V: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Kootenai County, Idaho.
