AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, 1974, APPROPRIATING \$97,454.73 TO PAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR SAID YEAR, LEVYING SUFFICIENT TAX UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR THE GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That the sum of \$97,454.73 be appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities for the City of Dalton Gardens for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of January, 1974.

SECTION II: That the objects and purposes for which said appropriation is made and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows, to-wit:

SECTION IV: That anticipated other revenues of said City for said fiscal year beginning January 1, 1974, are \$36,384.65; that the unexpended general fund and street fund balances are \$17,538.93 and \$11,966.15 respectively; and unexpended and anticipated revenue sharing receipts are \$17,340.00.

SECTION V: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Kootenai County, Idaho.
