ORDINANCE NO. 53

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, ADOPTING THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE, 1973 EDITION, INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS, AND ANY SUBSEQUENT EDITIONS THEREOF, TO PROVIDE MINIMUM STANDARDS TO SAFEGUARD LIFE OR LIMB, HEALTH, PROPERTY AND PUBLIC WELFARE BY REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, QUALITY OF MATERIALS, LOCATION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF HEATING, VENTILATING, COOLING, REFRIGERATION SYSTEMS, INCINERATORS AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS HEAT-PRODUCING APPLIANCES:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That that certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of ^{Dalton} ~~Post Falls~~, marked and designated as UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE, 1973 Edition, International Conference of Building Officials, and any subsequent editions thereof, to provide minimum standards to safeguard life or limb, health, property and public welfare by regulating and controlling the design, construction, installation, quality of materials, location, operation and maintenance of heating, ventilating, cooling, refrigeration systems, incinerators and other miscellaneous heat-producing appliances, be and hereby is adopted as the Uniform Mechanical Code of the City of Dalton Gardens.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, published and printed at Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho, being the official newspaper of the City of Dalton Gardens.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 11th day of December, 1975.
