ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, ADOPTING THE LIFE SAFETY CODE OF THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION, 1973 EDITION AND ALL SUBSEQUENT EDITIONS THEREOF, TO SPECIFY MEASURES WHICH WILL PROVIDE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR FIRE SAFETY NECESSARY IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That that certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, marked and designated as LIFE SAFETY CODE, 1973 Edition, and all subsequent editions thereof, to specify measures which will provide minimum standards for fire safety necessary in the public interest, be and hereby is adopted as the Life Safety Code of the City of Dalton Gardens.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, published and printed at Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho, being the official newspaper of the City of Dalton Gardens.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 11th day of December, 1975.
