ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, ADOPTING THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE SPECIFICATIONS FOR MAKING BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES USED BY THE PUBLIC ACCESSIBLE TO, AND USABLE BY, THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, 1961 EDITION AND ANY SUBSEQUENT EDITIONS THEREOF, TO MAKE ALL BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES USED BY THE PUBLIC ACCESSIBLE TO AND FUNCTIONAL FOR, THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, TO, THROUGH, AND WITHIN THEIR DOORS, WITHOUT LOSS OF FUNCTION, SPACE, OR FACILITY WHERE THE GENERAL PUBLIC IS CONCERNED:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That that certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, makred and designated as AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE SPECIFICATIONS FOR MAKING BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES ACCESSIBLE TO AND USABLE BY THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, and any subsequent editions thereof, to make all buildings and facilities used by the public accessible to, and functional for, the physically handicapped to, through, and within their doors, without loss of function, space, or facility where the general public is concerned, be and is hereby adopted as the Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities Accessible to and Usable by the Physically Handicapped of the City of Dalton Gardens.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published and printed at Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho, being the official newspaper of the City of Dalton Gardens.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 11th day of December, 1975.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That that certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, marked and designated as AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE SPECIFICATIONS FOR MAKING BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES ACCESSIBLE TO AND USABLE BY THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, and any subsequent editions thereof, to make all buildings and facilities used by the public accessible to, and functional for, the physically handicapped to, through, and within their doors, without loss of function, space, or facility where the general public is concerned, be and is hereby adopted as the Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities Accessible to and Usable by the Physically Handicapped of the City of Dalton Gardens.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published and printed at Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho, being the official newspaper of the city of Dalton Gardens.
