ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, ADOPTING THE IDAHO MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS, RULES OF THE ROAD, CHAPTERS 5, 6 AND 7, TITLE 49 IDAHO CODE, REVISED THROUGH ACTS OF THE 1977 LEGISLATIVE SESSION, PUBLISHED BY AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT, FOR REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE MUNICIPALITY, ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON ALL STREETS IN THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, AND ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, and designated as Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws, Rules of the Road, Chapters 5, 6, and 7, Title 49 Idaho Code, Revised Through the Acts of the 1977 Legislative Session, Published by Authority of the Department of Law Enforcement, Boise, Idaho, be and is hereby adopted as the motor vehicle code of the City of Dalton Gardens for the regulation of motor vehicles within the Municipality.

SECTION 2: That it shall be unlawful to operate a vehicle on any of the streets in the City of Dalton Gardens at a speed in excess of Twenty-five (25) miles per hour, except on the following streets and thoroughfares where the speed limit shall be Thirty-five (35) miles per hour:

North one-half of Dalton Avenue
Prairie Avenue
West Canfield Avenue between Fourth Street and
Government Way
Hanley Avenue
Wilbur Avenue
Fifteenth Street
Fourth Street


SECTION 3: That it shall be unlawful to operate any vehicle in any school, church or special zone at a rate of speed greater than that prescribed by the mayor and council when appropriate signs are placed at such zones.

SECTION 4: Any violation of any of the provisions of said Idaho Motor Vehicle Laws shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$300.00 or imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, or both such fine or imprisonment.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 6: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, printed and published at Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho, being the official newspaper of the City of Dalton Gardens.

 SECTION 1: That a certain
 document, three (3) copies of
 which are on file in the office of

 Hanley Avenue
 Wilbur Avenue
 Fifteenth Street
 Fourth Street

SECTION 3: That it shall be un-
 lawful to operate any vehicle in
 any school, church or special zone
 at a rate of speed greater than
 that prescribed by the mayor and
 council when appropriate signs
 are placed at such zones.

SECTION 4: Any violation of
 any of the provisions of said Idaho
 Motor Vehicle Laws shall be
 punishable by a fine not to exceed
 \$300.00 or imprisonment not to ex-
 ceed six (6) months, or both such
 fine or imprisonment.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or
 parts of ordinances in conflict
 herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This ordinance

 force and effect upon its passage,
 approval and publication in one is-
 sue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a
 newspaper of general circulation
