ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That commencing January 1, 1980, the compensation to be paid to the Mayor shall be the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per month, and to the Councilmen the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, published and printed in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, being the official newspaper of said City.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council held on July 5, 1979.
