ORDINANCE NO. 98

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That commencing January 1, 1986, the compensation to be paid to the Mayor shall be the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) per month, and to the Councilmen the sum of SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$75.00) per month.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, published and printed in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, being the official newspaper of said City.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council held on July 2, 1985.

SECTION 3: That a general tax upon all taxable property within the limits of said City sufficient to raise the sum of \$27,500.00 be levied for said fiscal year beginning on the first day of October, 1985.

SECTION 4: That anticipated tax receipts are \$27,500.00; there is an unexpended general fund balance after all warrants are paid in the amount of \$53,474.53; unexpended street fund balance in the amount of \$15,449.40; and anticipated other receipts of \$121,564.00.

SECTION 5: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Kootenai County, Idaho.
