

CITY OF DALTON GARDENS

ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING FIREARMS, PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS THERETO, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION. Whenever the term "firearms" is used in this Ordinance, the term shall mean any instrument used in the propulsion of shot, pellets, or bullets, or other harmful objects by the action of gunpowder exploded within it, or by the action of compressed air within it, or by the power of springs, and including what are commonly known as air rifles and B-B guns.

SECTION 2. DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge firearms of any kind or description within the limits of the municipality.


SECTION 3. EXCEPTIONS. This Ordinance shall not apply to peace officers in the discharge of their duties, to persons discharging a firearm at dogs not on the premises of the owner which are worrying, wounding, or killing any livestock or poultry which is raised and kept in captivity for domestic purposes, or to the slaughtering on the premises where an animal is to be butchered.

SECTION 4. PENALTY. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$300.00 or be imprisoned in the county jail for a period

of not exceeding thirty (30) days, or be both so fined and imprisoned. Each time such violation is committed shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.


SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Dalton Gardens.
