ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO, ENTITLED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 1986, AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1987, APPROPRIATING \$217,955.00 TO PAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR SAID PERIOD, SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That the sum of \$217,955.00 be appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of October, 1986, and ending on the 30th day of September, 1987.

SECTION 2: That the objects and purposes for which said appropriation is made and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows, to-wit:


SECTION 3: That a general tax upon all taxable property within the limits of said City sufficient to raise the sum of \$28,500.00 be levied for said fiscal year beginning on the first day of October, 1986.

SECTION 4: That anticipated tax receipts are \$28,500.00; there is an unexpended general fund balance after all warrants are paid in the amount of \$58,075.48; unexpended street fund balance in the amount of \$5,405.00; and anticipated other receipts of \$125,974.52.

SECTION 5: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO, ENTITLED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON SEPTEMBER 1, 1986, AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1987, PROPRIATING \$217,955.00 TO PAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR SAID PERIOD, SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SUCH APPROPRIATION IS MADE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That the sum of \$217,955.00 be appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of October, 1986, and ending on the 30th day of September, 1987.
