ORDINANCE NO. 107

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 105 OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO, ELIMINATING SECTION (7) REGARDING HOME OCCUPATION PERMITS IN ITS ENTIRETY AND PROVIDING THAT ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY REPEALED TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY TO GIVE THIS ORDINANCE FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

Section 1 - Section 7 of the "City of Dalton Gardens Zoning Ordinance" No. 105 shall be entirely eliminated from Ordinance No. 105. All other sections and provisions of Ordinance No. 105 shall remain in force and effect.

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Kootenai County, Idaho.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council held on March 2, 1989.
