

CITY OF DALTON GARDENS
ORDINANCE NO. 115

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO, PROHIBITING BEER, WINE OR LIQUOR ON CITY PROPERTY OR PARKS WITHIN THE CITY OF DALTON AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION I: It is unlawful for any person to consume any beer, wine or intoxicating liquor, or have in his or her possession any opened or open containers or receptacles containing beer, wine or intoxicating liquor in any public park within the city or in any motor vehicle moving or parked on a public thoroughfare, street or highway in the city.

SECTION II: Violations of any provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on its passage and approval and the publication of a summary thereof in one (1) issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, the official newspaper of the City of Dalton Gardens.
