ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION BY REFERENCE OF THE IDAHO RESIDENTIAL ENERGY STANDARDS FOR BUILDING STANDARDS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

Section 1: Idaho Code Section 44-2301 et seq, Construction Standards for Energy Conservation, be and hereby are adopted as the Building Codes of the City of Dalton for the regulating of the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair of all buildings and/or structures in the city of Dalton, Kootenai County, Idaho. Said regulations are on file in the office of the Clerk of the City.

Section 2: That the City of Dalton through its building inspector is authorized to accept builder certification and issue permits, which when taken to the appropriate electric utility by the builder or owner, will authorize permanent power connection. Fees for processing builder certifications and issuing permits shall be set by resolution of the City of Dalton.

Section 3: The City shall enforce and seek remedies for breaches of the terms of the Ordinance, as provided by the Laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4: If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or property is held invalid, the remainder of the chapter or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.


Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and one publication in the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, and being the official newspaper of the City of Dalton.
