UNTIL 8:00 P.M. FOR A CITY ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF Dalton Gardens,
IDAHO:

Section 1. The polls for all general election held November 2nd., 1993 at the City of Dalton Gardens City Hall, 6360 N. 4th Street, Dalton Gardens, Idaho shall be opened from 8:00 a.m. and remain open until all registered electors of that precinct have voted or until 8:00 p.m., whichever comes first.

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, published and printed in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, being the official newspaper of said City.

PASSED under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens at a special meeting of the Mayor and City Council held on September 13, 1993.
