

CITY OF DALTON GARDENS

ORDINANCE NO. 131

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2, SECTIONS 1 AND 3 UNDER GENERAL TRAFFIC PROVISIONS OF THE DALTON GARDENS CITY CODE, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

Title 8, Chapter 2, Section 1 of the City Code of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

"8-2-1: SPEED LIMITS: It shall be unlawful to operate a vehicle on any of the streets in the City at a speed in excess of twenty five (25) miles per hour, except on the following streets and thoroughfares where the speed limit shall be thirty five (35) miles per hour:

North Dalton Avenue, except 25 mph when children are present.
South Prairie Avenue, except from Fourth Street to Mt. Carrol
~~West Canfield Avenue between Fourth Street and Government Way~~
~~Hanley Avenue~~
~~Wilbur Avenue~~
Fifteenth Street
Fourth Street"

Title 8, Chapter 2, Section 3-A is hereby amended as follows:


SECTION 3-A:

"A. Truck Route Established: It is unlawful for any person to drive or operate a motor vehicle, other than street maintenance equipment ~~of a gross weight exceeding forty-six thousand (46,000) pounds~~ exceeding the allowable load per inch width of tire as set forth in Idaho Code 49-1002(1) over any street of the City excepting Prairie Avenue from Government Way to Baillie Street".

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one (1) issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, published and printed in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, being the official newspaper of said City.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and enacted an Ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council held on August 4, 1994.
