AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That commencing January 1, 1996, the compensation to be paid to the Mayor shall be the sum of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS per month, and to the Councilpersons, the sum of TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS per month.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one (1) issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, published and printed in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, being the official newspaper of said City.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council held on August 3, 1995.
