ORDINANCE NO. 149

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO CHANGING THE METHOD OF DETERMINING BUSINESS LICENSE FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO.

SECTION 1: That Title Three (3), Chapter One (1) Section Four (4), that is 3-1-4 of the City Code of Dalton Gardens shall be amended as follows:

"LICENSE FEE: The license fee shall be the sum of ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)~~ fifty dollars (\$50.00) per business license."


Thus, business license fees in the City of Dalton Gardens shall be the sum of \$50.00.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.


SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho.

Enforcement date for this ordinance shall be on and after January 1, 2000.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO CHANGING THE METHOD OF DETERMINING BUSINESS LICENSE FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO.

SECTION 1: That Title Three (3), Chapter One (1) Section Four (4), that is 3-1-4 of the City Code of Dalton Gardens shall be amended as follows:

"LICENSE FEE: The license fee shall be the sum of ~~twenty five dollars (\$25.00)~~ *fifty dollars (\$50.00)* per business license."

Thus, business license fees in the City of Dalton Gardens shall be the sum of \$50.00.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho.
