AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS ALTERING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, DISANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY THEREFROM AND SETTING FORTH THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY AS ALTERED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, KOOTENAI COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That the following land be disannexed from the limits of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho:

Dalton Avenue right of way according to the plat of DALTON GARDENS ADDITION TO HAYDEN LAKE IRRIGATED LANDS (Book B of Plats at Page 151, records of Kootenai, County, Idaho) situated in the Northwest Quarter of Section 36, Township 51 North, Range 4 West, Boise Meridian, said right of way being 20 feet in width, and being that portion lying easterly of the easterly right of way of Government way and lying westerly of the easterly right of way of Fourth Street described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the East right of way line of Government Way (former U.S. Highway 95) and the East-West centerline of said Section 36, said beginning point being 30 feet East of the West 1/4 Corner of said Section 36;

Thence easterly along said East-West centerline of Section 36, 2625 feet, more or less, to the Center 1/4 Corner of said Section 36;

Thence continuing along said East-West centerline, 30 feet, more or less, to the easterly right of way of Fourth Street;

Thence leaving said East-West centerline northerly 20 feet, more or less to the point of intersection
