ORDINANCE NO. 152

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HUNTING WITHIN THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: HUNTING PROHIBITED: It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to chase, drive, pursue, follow after on the trail of, shoot at, stalk or lie in wait for any wildlife. Nothing herein shall prohibit the stalking, attracting, searching for or lying in wait for any wildlife by an unarmed person solely for the purpose of observing or photographing that wildlife.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in one (1) issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, published and printed in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, being the official newspaper of said City.


