AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO
ESTABLISHING A METHOD FOR DECLARING AND PLACING LOAD LIMITS ON
THE STREETS WITHIN DALTON GARDENS.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO.

SECTION 1: Whenever the Lakes Highway District declares and
establishes load limits on the streets within its jurisdiction,
the City of Dalton Gardens shall post the streets within the
City with the same limits, and said limits established by Lakes
Highway District shall then apply to the Streets within Dalton
Gardens.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in
conflict herewith are repealed.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in
full force and effect upon its passage and publication in one
(1) issue of the Coeur d'Alene Press, a newspaper of general
circulation published in Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho.

Passed under suspension of the rules upon a roll call vote taken and duly enacted an ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 6th day of April, 2000.
