

SUMMARY OF  
CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO  
ORDINANCE NO. 200

AN ORDINANCE OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE 5 CHAPTER 11 TO AMEND TEMPORARY SIGN PERMIT STANDARDS AND APPROVAL PROCEDURES IN THE RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

In accordance with Idaho Code §50-901A, the following is a Summary of Ordinance 200 of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho:

1. Title 5-11-2, DEFINITIONS: of the present Dalton Gardens, Idaho municipal Code adds and/or amends definitions of the following:

A-FRAME SIGN: On premises portable, freestanding signs intended for use in parking lots, upon sidewalks and along roadways

Awning Signs – See Canopy

BANNER: A flexible material on which a sign is displayed. It may be anchored to the outside of a building or other structure, affixed to windows, or otherwise displayed on exterior surfaces.

GROUND SIGN: ~~The same as a temporary sign supported by uprights or braces placed upon the ground and not attached to any part of any building.~~ A freestanding sign that is not secured to a foundation, attached to any part of a building or other secondary support structure.

PORTABLE SIGN: ~~Same as Temporary Sign as defined in this Section.~~ Portable signs are signs not permanently attached to the ground or building, typically with a power-cord for connection to an electrical source, mounted on frame, trailer, axle, and tires not affixed to the ground and readily removable using ordinary hand tools.

TEMPORARY PROMOTION SIGN: A banner, pennant, poster, or advertising display constructed of cloth, canvas, light fabric, paper, cardboard, plastic, metal or other light material, with or without frames, that is not permanently attached to a building ~~or the ground~~ and which is intended to be displayed for a limited period. ~~not be exceed forty five (45) days per calendar year per business location.~~

2. Title 5-11-4, GENERAL EXEMPTIONS, of the present Dalton Gardens, Idaho municipal Code is amended to provide that signs must be attached to a building in which persons congregate for civic, political educational, religious, social or recreational purposes, displaying the name and nature of the occupancy, and

information as to the condition of use, admission or time of services or event; deletes reference to any multi-family residence zone and signs advertising rental of new apartment units and apartment complexes; prohibits signs in the public right of way and provides that the City may remove signs placed in the public right of way; provides that banners shall be erected no more than seven days prior to an event and be removed within two days after termination of the event; and prohibits the placement of signs on fences.

3. Title 5-11-5, RESIDENTIAL ZONES, GENERALLY of the present Dalton Gardens, Idaho municipal Code is amended to add the provision that A-frame signs promoting civic or community events or school enrollment are allowed by permit in residential zones for a period of time not to exceed thirty days per calendar year.

4. Title 5-11-6, COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL ZONES, GENERALLY of the present Dalton Gardens, Idaho municipal Code is amended to add a provision allowing by permit certain temporary promotional signs in commercial and industrial zones, restricted to no more than four (4) permits per year each valid for no more than two (2) weeks; sets forth standards for upkeep and maintenance; limits nontraditional (including inflatable) signs to one (1) permit per year; sets forth size restrictions of temporary promotional signs; provides that all temporary signs must be attached to a permanent building, and prohibits signs to be erected or adhered to fences, light poles or light standards. Additionally, a provision is added for A-Frame signs within the commercial and industrial zones which sets forth the number of permits allowed per calendar year, sign placement, standards of construction, time of placement, and prohibits portable signs.


5. Title 5-11-8, PERMIT APPLICATION; FEE of the present Dalton Gardens, Idaho municipal Code is amended to add A-Frame.

6. This Ordinance was passed on December 4, 2008.


7. The Ordinance takes effect upon publication of this Summary in the Coeur d'Alene Press.
