

ORDINANCE NO. 215

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALTON GARDENS MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 3 ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE, THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION CODES NUMBERED 501A AND 1194, THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, THE INTERNATIONAL FUEL AND GAS CODE AND THE LIFE SAFETY NFPA 101; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

IT IS ORDAINED by the mayor and city council of the City of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho as follows:

Section 1. That added to Title 4, Chapter 1, is the following:

INTERNATIONAL CODES ADOPTED:

The following nationally recognized codes are adopted as the official building codes of the city of Dalton Gardens:

1. The International Mechanical Code as published by the International Code Council.
2. National Fire Protection Association Codes number 4011 and 1194 and the accepted engineering practice standards contained therein for compliance by the manufactured home recreational vehicle industry.
3. The International Fire Code as published by the International Code Council.
4. The International Fuel Gas Code, as published by the International Code Council.
5. Life safety NFPA 101, as published by the National Fire Protection Association.

The adopted versions of the foregoing codes shall be deemed superseded by successive versions of such codes as they are adopted or approved by the state of Idaho effective on the date any such codes are made effective.

Section 2. Severability.

The ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. Should any portion of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect and shall be read to carry out the purpose(s) of the ordinance before the declaration of partial invalidity.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions.

All other provisions of the current Dalton Gardens City Code or ordinances of the city of Dalton Gardens which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.



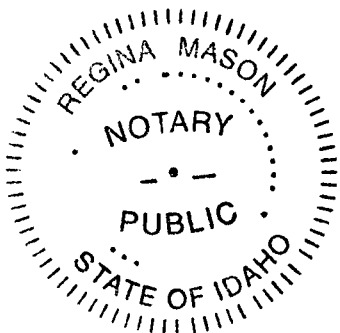
