

SUMMARY OF
CITY OF DALTON GARDENS, IDAHO
ORDINANCE NO. 219

In accordance with Idaho Code §50-901A, the following is a Summary of Ordinance 219 of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho:

1. An ordinance of Dalton Gardens, Idaho, a political subdivision of the State of Idaho, known as the SIGN ORDINANCE, amending Title 5, Chapter 11 of the Dalton Gardens municipal code and providing for severability and an effective date.


2. The ordinance regulates the construction, erection, maintenance, electrification, illumination, type, size, number and location of signs in various zoning districts and provides for non-conforming signs and sign needs of special areas, facilities, centers and districts. The ordinance also provides for a method of application for sign permits and appeals. The ordinance also provides for violations and penalties.

3. This Ordinance was passed on July 5, 2012.


4. The Ordinance takes effect upon publication of this Summary in the Coeur d'Alene Press.
