Workshop Meeting Minutes

- 2. Wildlife Management Workshop- called to order by Mayor Edwards at 5:00 PM**

Attorney Kling gave an overview: Currently, the City of Dalton Gardens Code 7-1-3 prohibits hunting. The City met with the Idaho Fish & Game. If the City began allowing hunting, it could require all of the standards of Idaho Fish & Game plus the regulations of Dalton Gardens. City of Dalton Gardens Deer Hunting Standard Operating Procedure was developed.


