

Summary of Workshop of Dalton Gardens City Council
Thursday, April 23, 2020 @ 6:00 PM
Via Teleconference on Zoom

The workshop was called to order by Mayor Dan Edwards at 6:08 PM.

Attendees included: Dan Edwards, Mayor, city council members: Robert Wuest, Carrie Chase, Ray Craft and Aaron O'Brien. Also attending were Attorney Caitlin Kling, Valerie Anderson, City Clerk and Deputy Clerk Teresa Janzen. Guests on the call included Matt Gillis – Welch Comer Engineering and Captain Matt Street – KCSO.

The council discussed several traffic issues as reducing through traffic in Dalton Gardens, speed humps, striping of 4th street and rebuilding of intersection corners on streets. The council discussed many different ways to start reducing traffic and stated that safety is the number one priority to be considered. Many different comments were also received by residents of Dalton Gardens.

The council also discussed city engineer contract and going out for request for qualifications to hire a new engineer to update the transportation plan and do some traffic studies in Dalton.


The council directed the City Planner to start working on updates to the sign ordinance for the city.

The council discussed the mailing of a postcard and doing a monkey survey questionnaire for the residents to give the council their concerns and what they would like to see done with the traffic issues in the City.


The council also discussed the calling of a special meeting and the procedures which should be followed in doing so.
