The argument of it hurting the 'rural feel' of Dalton Gardens is pretty contradictory to the point of hypocritical. The recent actions of Dalton Gardens putting up the flashing speed controls signs all over Dalton Gardens that operate 24 hours a day all year round (only 1 that I am aware of is near Dalton's elementary school.) ..and church and some business signs are also being lit 24 hours a day..

The continued building of McMansions in Dalton while letting other have piles of dead cars and trash and huge political signs (some with curse words even) seem to be more effecting the 'rural feel' of Dalton. So how about a real traffic plan that facilitates efficient pass through of the community at reasonable speed limits (i.e. 35) on 4th and 15th seems and a proper 4th & Prairie intersections seem like perhaps more important items for Dalton Gardens City Council to be focusing on what is occurring along its roadways.

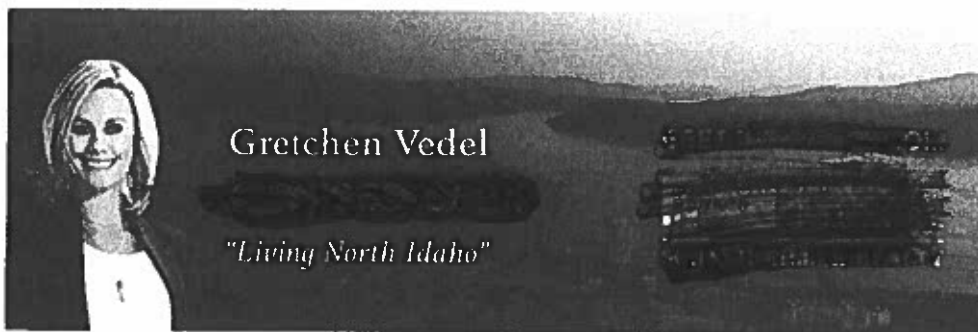

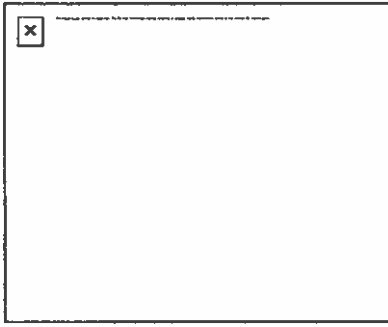

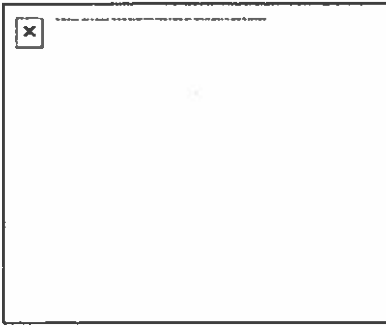

We moved this past summer, and had to 'transfer' him back to Dalton even though we only live 5 minutes away now. It was worth it!

Dalton is a great school, and a great community within Dalton Gardens! **The school serves as a touching point between surrounding communities, the school district, parents, staff, teachers and students.** It lets us all know important issues & keeps us connected.

However, currently, **CdA School District does not have a good way of communicating with parents who don't have easy access to internet/email.** They have to communicate either through email or through the district's cumbersome Skyward website. CdA assumes everyone has easy access to the internet while many on the district do not have it. Written newsletters/notices are not sent out, and if they were, the amount of paper/ink/time expended would be notable and as a result, slow to react.

The sign would address those underserved parents and those issues within the district by allowing the school to quickly notify parents of emergent issues.

Imagine the threat of a school shooting. It's the reality parents, like myself, find ourselves in. Imagine that you are a busy parent who hasn't heard about anything during the day. Imagine heading towards the school and seeing emergency service vehicles with no way to know what's happened to your child. Imagine the panic that would set in.

This is an overly dramatic example, but now, imagine that instead of this being an emergency, that this was only a drill... and that the sign was changed that afternoon to reflect that the drill was going to happen or had happened. Imagine the instant relief. **Timely community communications are important in today's climate.**

As a parent of a Dalton student for the past three years, I would ask that you consider what a notification system could mean not just for the neighborhood, but also for the larger community. I believe that it will not deter from the country feel of our dear community. The sign can be dimmed or turned off as needed while still alerting parents to necessary information during the daylight hours.
