Meeting was called to order by Mayor Fletcher

Roll Call: Councilmember Drechsel, Egbert and Smith. Councilmember Jordan was absent. Also present was Valerie Anderson, City Clerk.

BUDGET HEARING FY 2019-2020

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Dalton Gardens, Kootenai County, Idaho will hold a public hearing for the consideration of the proposed budget for the fiscal period October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020, pursuant to the provisions of Section 50-1002, Idaho Code. The proposed expenditures and revenues for the fiscal year 2019-2020 have been tentatively approved by the City Council. Publication dates for the notice of the public hearing were August 8, 2019 and August 15, 2019 in the legal section of the Coeur d'Alene Press.

Public comment period was opened.

Mike Neher – 6056 Colfax Street – He commented on the enhanced patrol services and the number of cars that are going through Dalton on a daily basis. The speed signs are working but we need to get a deputy on staff to write citations in Dalton.

Carrie Chase – 7512 4th Street – She questioned the 4th Street line items on the budget in the revenue and expenditure, the parks and Kootenai Area Transportation.

Jim Kimball – 6975 N. 16th Street – He asked about the legal services line item, streets and traffic.

Lila Tatum – 7080 N. Valley Street – She asked questions about the Professional Services, Roads and Code Enforcement.

Councilmember Drechsel commented on the Kootenai Area Transportation and stated that he was checking into the fees which are paid by the county and the surrounding cities.

Public comment period was closed.

Councilmember Smith made a motion to accept the 2019-2020 budgets. Councilmember Egbert seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Councilmember Drechsel – no, Councilmember Smith – yes, Councilmember Egbert – yes. Motion carried.

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #262:


An ordinance of the City of Dalton Gardens, Idaho entitled the annual appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019, and ending on September 30, 2020, appropriating the sum of \$923,775.00 to defray the expenses and liabilities of the City of Dalton Gardens for said fiscal year, authorizing a levy of a sufficient tax upon the taxable property and specifying the objects and purposes for which said appropriation is made.

Councilmember Smith moved to suspend reading of Ordinance 262 on three different days and have the title read once. Councilmember Egbert seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Councilmember Drechsel – no, Councilmember Smith – yes, Councilmember Egbert – yes. Motion carried.


